Successful Caregiving

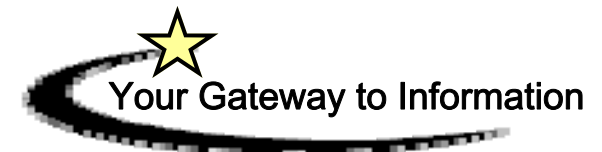
