



Checklist For Completing Application For Special Permit For Animals

The following must be received by the City of Canby prior to the requested approval of keeping certain non-domestic animals in the Canby City Limits:

A completed Application For Special Permit For Animals to include:

- Names, addresses and signatures of all affected neighbors (all neighbors sharing your property lines).
- **Please note: Roosters are not permitted inside Canby's city limits.**
- There is a one-time \$10 permit application fee for keeping certain non-domestic animals. The permit, once approved, has no expiration; however, the permit will be immediately revoked if the City receives complaints related to noise, sanitation or other conditions.

Mail the completed form to City of Canby, PO Box 930, Canby, OR 97013; or hand deliver to City Hall located at 182 N Holly, Canby.

Upon receipt of your completed application, the City Administrator will consider your request. You will be notified of his decision.

§ 6.04.010 Definitions.

For the purpose of this chapter, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning.

Animals means all nonhuman living creatures, including bees and chickens, but excepting small fish and domestic pets.

Domestic Pets means dogs, cats, rabbits, small birds, hamsters and similar domesticated rodents.

§ 6.04.020 Keeping of certain animals prohibited.

Except for domestic pets and except as otherwise provided in § 6.04.030, the keeping of animals in the city is prohibited.

§ 6.04.030 Special permits.

Special permits for the keeping of other than domestic pets may be granted administratively by the City Administrator on terms and conditions and for periods of time as may be determined by the Administrator. Application for these permits shall be filed with the City Administrator for review and determination. A decision of the Administrator allowing a permit may be appealed to the City Council. The Council may hold a public hearing on the appeal after notice of the hearing is given in the usual manner provided for public hearings.
